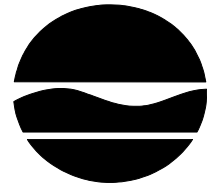

The DEC charges \$50 for the exam fee (If you are attending the pre-exam training session, please bring a check or money order for the \$50 exam with you that day). Upon passing the exam, the certification fee is \$225 for your first category (except \$100 for cat. 3A or 3B only). This certification will be valid for a 3 year period (only 1 year for cat. 3A or 3B only). If adding a category, a letter of experience or 12 recert credits are needed to be allowed into the test; also certification fee to be determined at the time of the exam dependent on expiration date of current license.
